1) CASCA Elections 2019

At the Annual General Meeting (AGM) in June, several positions on the CASCA Board of Directors will become vacant. Specifically, the terms of three Directors (Erik Rosolowsky, Kristine Spekkens, and Samar Safi-Harb) are ending. In addition, the terms of the Secretary (James Di Francesco) and Treasurer (Nicole St-Louis) are also ending. 2) CASCA Membership

4) Membership Changes since the 2018 AGM

CASCA lost **Dr. Ian Halliday**, on 06 June 2018 in his 90th year. Dr. Halliday obtained his PhD from the University of Toronto in 1954. Afterward, he joined the Dominion Observatory in Ottawa and then became part of the Upper Atmospheric Research Section of the National Research Council, which later was folded into the Herzberg Institute for Astrophysics. His main research focus was meteor astronomy, including meteor spectroscopy, fireball and crater studies and meteorite recovery. In 1977, he led the establishment and operation of the Meteorite Observations and Recovery Project (MORP), a network of cameras in western Canada designed to recover recently fallen meteorites. Data from this network led to the still-definitive estimate of the meteorite impact rate on the Earth. Ian served as Editor of the Journal of the RASC from 1970 to 1975 and served as the national President of the RASC from 1980 to 1982. He was elected as a Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada in 1979. Asteroid 3944 was named Halliday in his honour in 1989. In particular, Dr. Halliday was a great supporter of CASCA. He was a member in good standing to his final year and his daughter read out to him Exploder messages when he could no longer read them himself.
